



Summer Japanese Language Program 2020

We are pleased to announce that the Summer Japanese Language Program will be held **online** in **September 2020**. The Program offers the opportunity to learn Japanese language and culture with the aim to contribute to the building of friendship between the people of BiH, its neighboring countries and Japan. The Program is organized within the framework of a collaborative agreement between University of Sarajevo, BiH and Sophia University (上智大学), Tokyo, Japan, and supported by the Japan Embassy in BiH.

The Program is communication-oriented and provides participants with the opportunity to talk about their own culture and get to know Japanese culture. It offers 5 courses of different levels from very beginners to more advanced. Each course consists of 6 small-sized classes over the period of three weeks (6 people in each class). Every course will be offered on both weekdays (Tuesday & Thursday) and weekends (Saturday & Sunday) with the same contents considering participants' availability. The three graduate students specialized in Japanese language pedagogy from Tokyo will teach these courses. Please see details of each course and teacher's introduction below.

Japanese 1-1 /1 -2	This course is designed for students who have never studied the Japanese language before. In this					
(Ms. Miyamoto)	course, you'll start off learning some basic phrases which are useful in daily conversation and Japanese letters					
	such as あいうアイウ. In the beginning, you might find learning Japanese difficult, but I try to incorporate many					
	interesting activities so that you can study Japanese having fun and be motivated to study Japanese more.					
	In this course, you'll also learn Japanese cultures in addition to the Japanese language. You'll be able to know					
	the Japanese lifestyles, Japanese cities, foods, the Japanese ways of thinking and so on. As for the cultural part,					
	I can deal flexibly according to what you're interested in and arrange what we do in classes.					
Japanese 2	This course is designed for students who have learnt Japanese for less than a year or who have take					
(Ms. Takano)	our Beginner or Japanese1.1 course last year. The aim of this course is to learn basic phrases in Japanese					
	and daily conversation. This course also introduces Japanese culture and will offer some Japanese cultural					
	experience.					
<mark>Japanese 3</mark>	This course is designed for students whose Japanese level is between beginner and intermediate. The aim of					
(Ms. Takano)	this course is to brush up speaking and listening skills. Students will learn Japanese phrases used in ordinary					
	situations through conversational practices. This course is aimed at students in the Level 1 of regular					
	Japanese course or who have learnt Japanese for more than a year and know basic Japanese grammar.					
	The knowledge of the Japanese writing system (Hiragana and Katakana) is required.					
<mark>Japanese 4</mark>	This course is designed for people who have already learnt basic knowledge of Japanese. The aim of this class					
(Ms. Matsushita)	is to enhance students' conversational skills in many practical situations. In this class, students will have a lot of					
	opportunities to speak about various topics. Also, some opportunities to improve students' Japanese listening					
	comprehension skill will be provided. This class is designed for students who are in the Level 2 or 3 of regular					
	Japanese Course or whose level is intermediate.					
Japanese 5	This course is designed for students who have basic knowledge of Japanese and can have a conversation in					
(Ms. Matsushita)	some daily situations. The aim of this course is to enable students to talk about not only daily subjects but also					
	less familiar ones in Japanese. In this course, we will deal with various topics through many activities such as					
	discussion, presentation and so on. The class activities could change in response to student's needs and					
	interest. This course is designed for students who are in the Level 3 or 4 of regular Japanese course or					
	whose level is upper - intermediate.
